The Beneficial Uses of Water Listening Session & Roundtable hosted by the Pala Band of Mission Indians and NAEPC, will be held on February 21, 2014. The State Water Resources Control Board is planning to adopt Subsistence Fishing (FISH) and Native American Cultural Uses (CUL) definitions in the near future. Beneficial uses form the cornerstone of water quality protection under regional Basin Plans. Once they are designated, water quality objectives can be established and water quality programs can be implanted to protect these uses.

Please join us in a listening session meeting between southern California Tribes and the State Water Resources Control Board to review proposed definitions and discuss how these Beneficial Uses will be a tool for Tribes to use in watershed protection.

Felicia Marcus, Chair State Water Resources Control Board, will be speaking about Beneficial Uses in Water Quality Regulation with tribes. Also, Gita Kapahi, Ombudsman, Tribal Liaison and Director of Public Participation, SWRCB and participation from the TMDL Section Division of Water will also be in attendance to hear from tribes.
